What's New at Heaton Place!

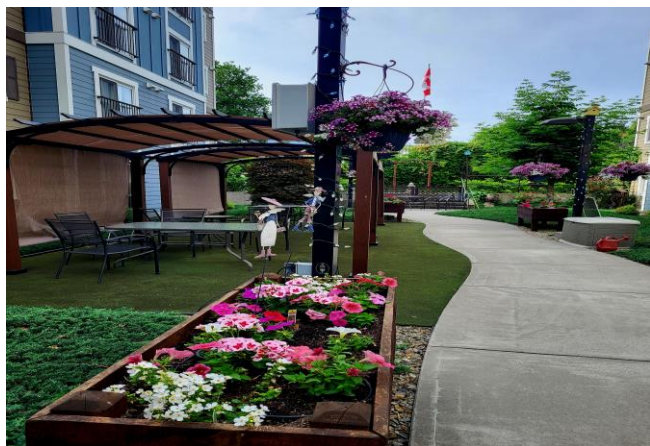
Greetings Everyone!
