Please welcome Wilma S, and Ed B to the Heaton family. Be sure to say hello and give them a warm welcome.



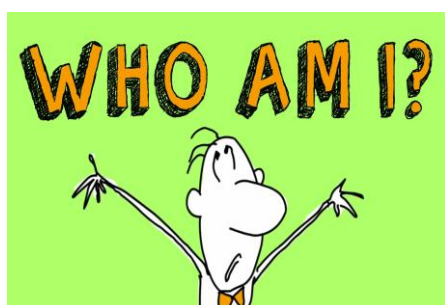
